We will be meeting in upper level, so use front door. I will open the building about 11 am because chairs and tables need to be setup. Any strong individuals to assist would be welcome.





Including their use in landscape design, the cultivation and development of new cultivars. The goals of the society shell be in keeping with those of the American Hosta Society.

Dan Boelman, RN, BSN is our guest speaker scheduled to present a very interesting, informative, and entertaining session at 2pm that will not leave you itching to know more about this horticultural and landscaping foe. You will learn almost everything there is to know about poison ivy! Dan brings 12 years of experience working with poison ivy, studying the ecology of poison ivy in landscapes, and his extensive experience in prevention and treatment of poison ivy rash. You'll learn about the different types of poison ivy, distinguish between other toxic plants often confused with poison ivy, how to prevent exposure, how to manage exposure to the toxin oil and reduce or eliminate rash reactions, and eradication of poison ivy plants. He will bring Zanfel samples for attendees and discuss his work with that Des Moinesbased company. He is the owner and chief eradication technician of the only lowa-licensed poison ivy eradication business, "lowa Poison Ivy Removal" which provides services primarily to central lowa, but also is available statewide.
