

Virgil D. Innis Obituary

Virgil D. Innis, 91, of Newburg, IA, died on Monday, March 28, 2011 at his home, two doors down from his son's home. A Celebration of Life was held Saturday, April 9th at Virgil's home. Iowa Cremation assisted the family with arrangements.
